Thomas Vangerud, 91, of Fargo, ND, passed away on Tuesday, February 2, 2021 at Beth any on 42nd in Fargo.

Thomas Osbourne Vangerud was born on August 22, 1929 to Melvin and Thea (Bakke) Vangerud in Fargo, ND. His family lived on area farmsteads before moving to the Vangerud home farm. Tom completed first grade in Kindred, and the remaining grades at the rural Christiania School, Kindred, ND. He was confirmed at Christiania Lutheran Church. Tom grad uated from Kindred High School in 1947. He attended NDSU where he was a member of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity.

Tom married June Hagen on May 26, 1951 at First Lutheran Church in Fargo, ND. They lived their life on the home farm where they raised their four children: Tim, Ellen, Sarah, and Ruth. They moved into Fargo, ND in 2012, and into Bethany on 42nd, Fargo, ND in 2019.

Tom spent several years farming. He also worked at local businesses before becoming the rural mail carrier out of the Kindred Post Office. He delivered mail to Kindred, Davenport, a nd Leonard areas for 28 years until he retired at the age of 78.
